FPHC CONSENSUS DAYS are for everyone as they can impact on all areas of prehospital care.

FPHC CONSENSUS DAYS form part of a structured process which looks to answer clinical questions which may not have strong clinical evidence to support it or to explore areas in which guidance is lacking. Following an investigation by a consensus team involving literature reviews and reviews of current national and international guidelines, as well discussions with subject matter experts, **FPHC CONSENSUS STATEMENTS** are then promoted, published and projected into current practice.

The aim of the **FPHC CONSENSUS DAY** is to bring all of the evidence together and formulate a consensus of opinion, backed by reasoned discussion/opinion where strong evidence does not exist.

FEES: There is no attendance fee as the debate and comments undertaken by the audience forms part of the process of consensus development and hence the importance of having representation from all levels of care givers.

FPHC CONSENSUS STATEMENTS are important, informative and inclusive days which drive change – be part of developing clinical practice. A full programme will be release in the near future.
