Notes on additional programme costs:

- Accommodation and catering costs for all modules are **extra to this fee** and are calculated and payable before attendance at each module.
- Travel to and from the modules, equipment and insurance **are not included** and are the responsibility of the student. Students are advised to obtain insurance cover from the British Mountaineering Council as ordinary travel insurance is not adequate.
- If you take more than one year to complete the diploma course and any of the fees increase, you may be required to pay the increased amount. However, if you choose to pay the whole of your tuition fee before starting the course, you will not have to pay any increase in fee for 2 years.

Cancellation Policy

2018-19

It is strongly recommended that students obtain adequate travel insurance to cover this policy. Students are advised to obtain insurance cover from the British Mountaineering Council as ordinary travel insurance is not adequate. Students who begin but cannot continue a module, for any reason including injury, cannot be refunded course fees and if required to retake the module will need to make a further payment to do so. Students are advised to insure themselves against this type of eventuality.

1. Students who confirm acceptance of a place on the diploma course, pay the first tuition payment and then subsequently cancel their place will be liable for charges as follows:
 - Cancellations on or before 31 August 2018: a full refund less a £50 administrative fee will be given;
 - Cancellations on or after 1 September 2018: students will be charged a £50 administrative fee and may be liable for the whole of the first tuition fee payment of £2000 unless someone can be found to take their place, extenuating circumstances excepted.
2. Students must confirm their attendance on each module at least six weeks before the start of the module. The exception to this is Module 4 – Mountain Skills 2, where confirmation twelve weeks ahead of the course start date is required.
3. Payment for modules must be received by the stated payment deadline and at least four weeks prior to the start of the module, including tuition fees and accommodation and catering charges.
4. Students who confirm their attendance at a module and then cancel less than four weeks before the start of the module will be liable for all non-recoverable expenses that we have already committed to on their behalf (such as Guide fees, faculty and speaker costs, accommodation charges, etc.), plus a £50 admin fee. The exception to this is Module 4 – Mountain Skills 2, where a minimum of six weeks notice is required before the student is liable for non-recoverable expenses.
5. Students who confirm their attendance at a module less than four weeks before the module starts cannot be guaranteed a place on the module. If a place is available and they subsequently cancel they will be liable for the whole fee for that module, plus any other costs that we incur on their behalf and are unable to recover, plus a £50 administrative fee.

The organisers retain the right to waive these cancellation charges if there are extenuating circumstances. The organisers will be the sole arbiters of what constitutes extenuating circumstances.
