The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh is the first medical Royal College to develop a Diploma in Urgent Medical Care (DipUMC RCSEd). The examination recognises the importance of the provision of Urgent Care in the NHS and is targeted at the many thousands of doctors, nurses and paramedics who deliver urgent medical care across the multitude of healthcare settings including emergency departments, urgent care and treatment centres, community settings and urgent primary care locations.

The Diploma in Urgent Medical Care examination will focus on the timely recognition, diagnosis and management of conditions, provide a national standard and allow clinicians to evidence their professional development in their practice in urgent medical care. The examination is comprised of a written paper and a structured oral component. Candidates are supported in their preparation by extensive syllabus and study guidance available on the RCSEd website.
